- Uses relevant technology to support and differentiate instruction.
- Establishes and sustains age-appropriate, effective classroom procedures to manage student behavior.
- Maintains order in accordance with the rules and disciplinary systems of the school.
- Provides formative and summative feedback on student work.
- Assigns and grades class work, homework, tests, and assignments.
- Encourages and monitors the progress of individual students and uses information to adjust teaching strategies.
- Maintains accurate and complete records of students' progress and development and prepares trimester reports both for parents and the students' cumulative files.
- Participates in department, school, and parent meetings.
- Communicates necessary information regularly to students, colleagues, and parents regarding student progress and student needs.
